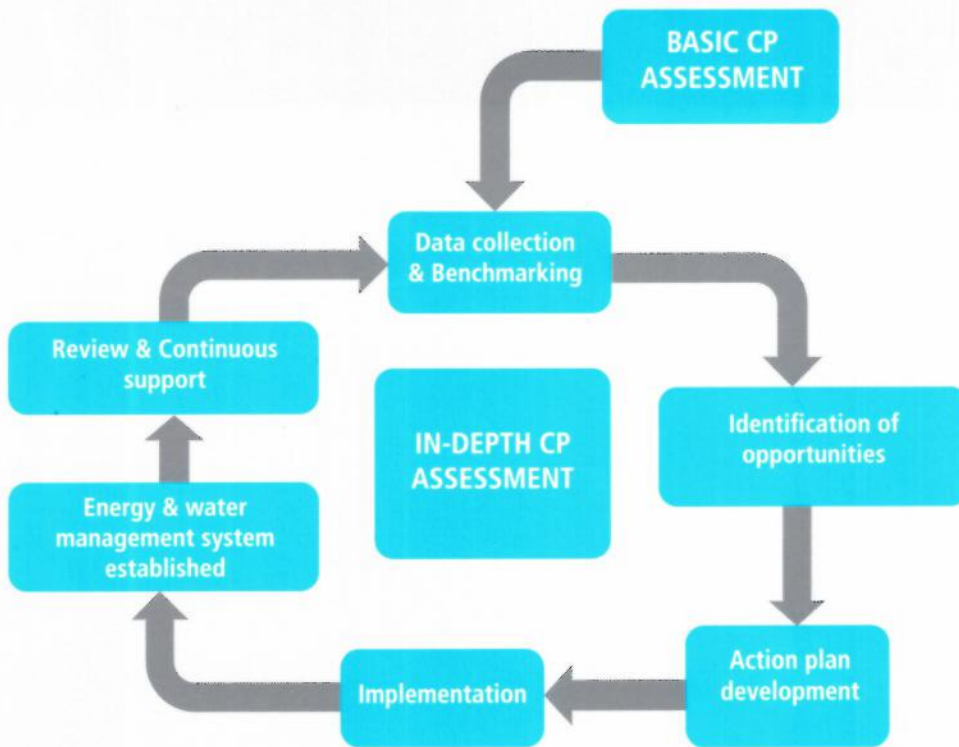
IFC led Advisory Partnership for Cleaner Textile is a joint initiative for International Brands and Apparel Trade Association (BGMEA). PaCT is working towards the implementation of best practices in the textile sector, with a focus on reducing resource consumption (energy, water, chemicals) and wastewater pollution.

PaCT plays an important role by directly supporting factories in setting and achieving Cleaner Production objectives. Factory level support is typically delivered in 3 steps.

The scope of In-depth CP Assessment is dyeing, finishing and laundry processes, and utilities including Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs) in the factory. It is not a pass/fail audit. In-depth CP Assessment is a continuation of Basic CP Assessment; it identifies more technologically advanced opportunities for improvements in water, energy, chemical consumption, wastewater, sludge generation, carbon footprint, leading to simultaneous improvement in environmental performance and overall efficiency. Minimizing the use of water in the dye house has the double benefit of process cost reduction and ETP efficiency improvement.

Areas addressed in In-depth CP Assessment





In-depth CP Assessment is not a one-off fix. Rather, it aims to change mindsets of factory management and embed the philosophy of continuous improvement.

It provides factories with a roadmap to continuous improvement in water, energy and chemicals by involving top management in resource management diagnostic programs like PaCT Advantage.
