REMOTE MONITORING PLATFORM





IFC led Advisory Partnership for Cleaner Textile is a joint initiative for International Brands and Apparel Trade Association (BGMEA). PaCT is working towards the implementation of best practices in the textile sector, with a focus on reducing resource consumption (energy, water, chemicals) and wastewater pollution.

REMOTE MONITORING OF FACTORY PERFORMANCE

PaCT, in its first phase, worked intensively with textile wet processing units, and tracked performance using manual options of data collection and analysis. PaCT II endeavors to monitor factories using remote data entry and customized analytics on a web-based platform. Through a secured database and in-built algorithms, users of the monitoring system monitor their KPIs against industry-wide benchmarks.

PaCT I data and information from 215 CP Assessments will be used to provide benchmarks across factory types, production data, geographical location, etc. Industry wide benchmarks across factory and product types will help set resource efficiency goals.

Key factory personnel will be trained on data entry methods, information access, analytics, and reporting. Information exchange between factories, brands, and consultants will be expedited through a secured server.




